IRFU Code of Conduct for Supporters

1. Remember young people play rugby for their enjoyment, not yours!
2. Encourage your child to play by the laws of the game.
3. Set a good example by applauding good play on both sides.
4. Never ridicule, humiliate or shout at young players for losing a match.
5. Be a good sport-never question the referee's decision.
6. Recognise and value the contribution of all volunteers in the game.
7. Understand the value of team sport and its importance.
8. Do not place an emphasis on winning at all costs.
9. The IRFU value your child's contribution to the game, make your child proud of you.

DATA PROTECTION
